# Ministry & Program Highlights:2021-2022

This fiscal and program year continues to represent strong recovery and return to a "new normalcy" resulting from the many challenges related to the initial turmoil of the COVID-19 pandemic. We have been privileged to welcome the return of most of our long-term guest groups, including Lander University, the Carolina Dog Society, our crafting groups (Rug Hooking, Knitting, and Quilting) and other church and community retreat groups. In addition, we welcomed twelve new retreat groups for events and programming this year.

Summer and Year-Round program opportunities continue to increase in both offerings and quality with a renewed focus on connection with churches in our presbyteries and the larger community we serve. Our summer camp program served 264 children and youth and employed 18 young adults on our summer staff. This summer, we increased our focus on "camperships" to provide financial assistance to camper-families for program registration, with a special focus on Foster Family support.

We continue strong programmatic partnerships with the Foothills Emmaus Community, Preserving Lake Greenwood, Westminster Presbyterian Church (Greenwood), Foothills Presbytery, Trinity Presbytery, Connect Lake Greenwood and the Chamber of Commerce in both Laurens and Greenwood counties. This year has also seen the development of new program partnerships with Impact2Purpose, a community based mentoring program providing support for families in Laurens County, and the South Carolina Via de Cristo Community. Most notably, we are excited for the newly forming partnership with Presbyterian College creating the Lake Campus program initiative that will bring PC students, faculty, staff and alumni to our property for community-building, academic and co-curricular activities.

Community Impact Programs (like our Red Letter Days) and church-focused programs (Church Officers' Retreats, Youth Leader and Educator Sabbath Days, etc.) continue to provide for a strengthening of our connection to the communities we serve. In the year ahead, we look forward to the completion of our community trails project, funded by a grant from Laurens County ARPA Funds, and to the implementation of several family-focused programs to be funded by a grant from the Balle Foundation. Indeed, we are thankful for all grants support and donations that help to fund the operations and assure that these programs are possible.



## 75th Anniversary

Many of our efforts this year have been focused on positioning for the celebration of our 75th Anniversary in 2023. We are currently looking to connect with past Campers, Guests and Staff as we share the story of our past 75 years and envision the future together!

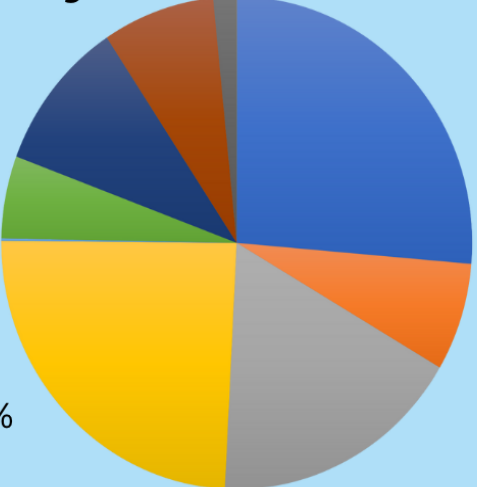

- Other Income - >1%

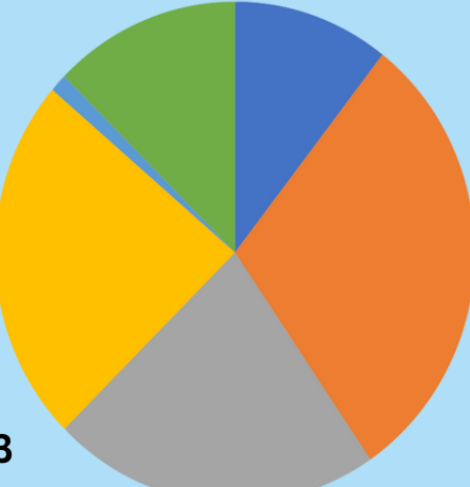


**Total Revenue: \$450,721.05**
